Discounts on professional instruction through workshops.

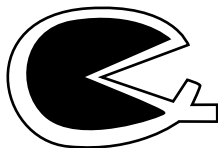
We are located within Xchanges Artists' Gallery and Studios.

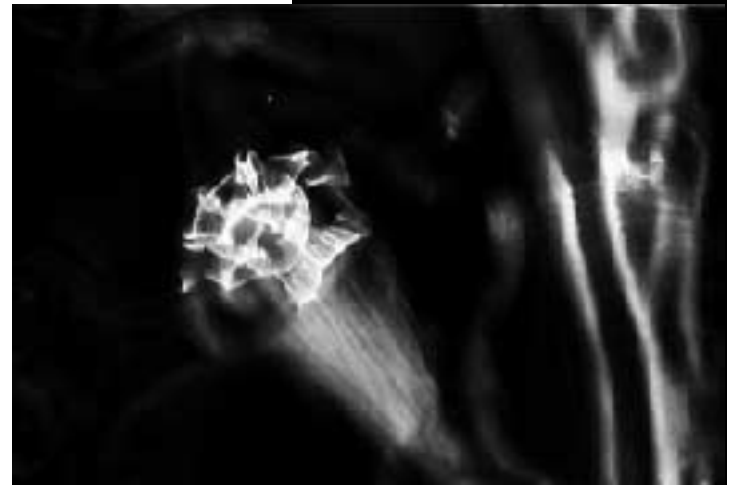
